RESOLUTION NO. 11-15

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BANDON, OREGON, ADOPTING A NEW SEWER RATE SCHEDULE.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council have determined that proper operation and maintenance of the wastewater treatment and collection systems, and payment of the debt service obligations, are necessary to protect the public health, safety, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, State Revolving Fund Loan Agreements between the City of Bandon and the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality, which provided funds for constructing the wastewater treatment plant, require that sewer rates be set at levels which will generate sufficient funds for proper operation and maintenance of the wastewater treatment and collection systems, and payment of the debt service obligations; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council have determined that sewer rates must be increased to provide adequate funds for the proper operation and maintenance of the wastewater treatment and collection systems, and payment of the debt service obligations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Bandon that the following Sewer Rate Schedule is hereby adopted:
