The trees block the sunlight from many of the garden plots, which causes issues with growing plants and the home owner worries about the trees falling on her home.

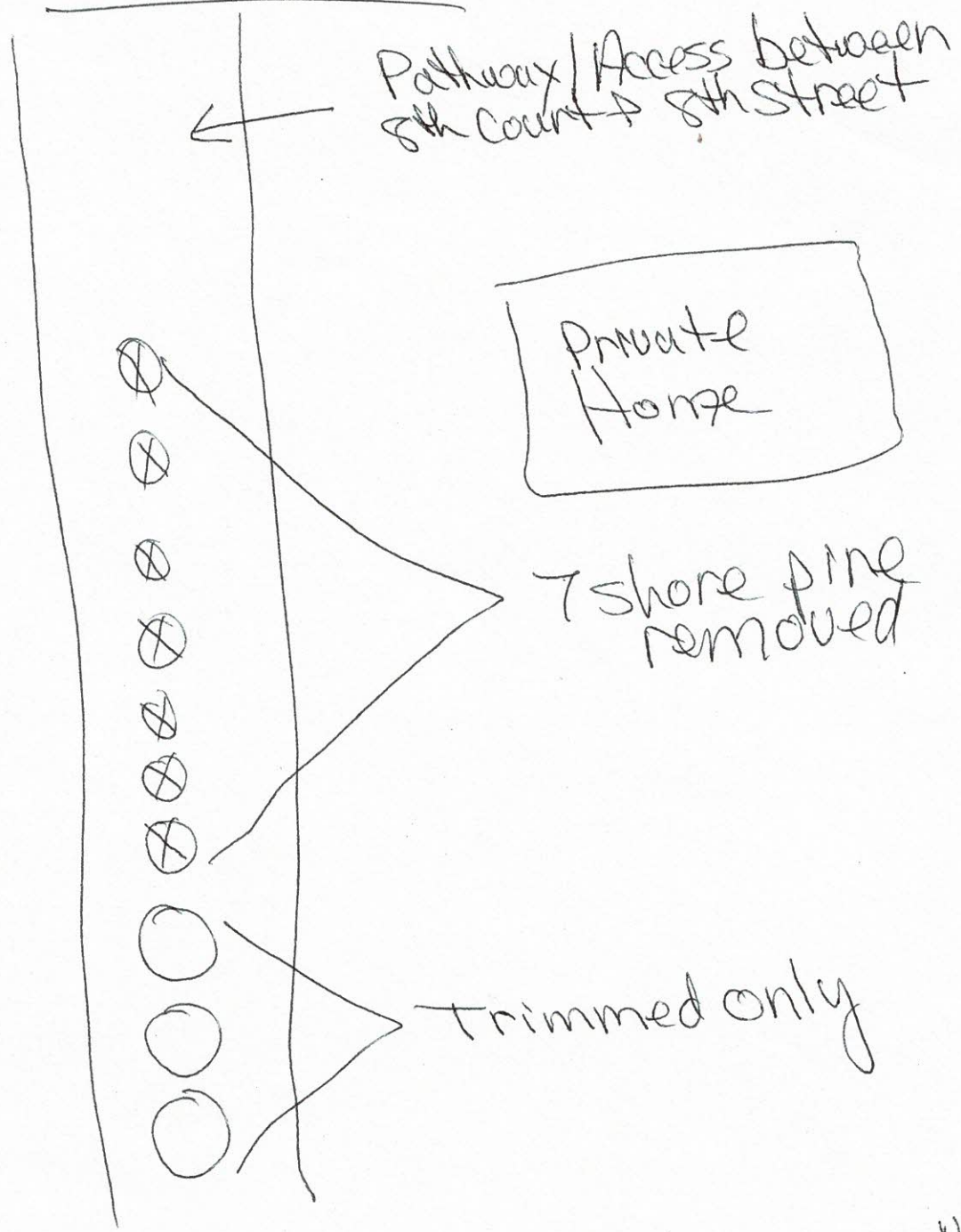

- Applicants are responsible for all necessary utility locates
 - Tree plantings must be of approved species
 - Property Owner is responsible for costs associated with removal and/or maintenance of trees
 - In-Lieu payment must be received before removal
 - Must obtain a public works permit for tree removal & notify the city of removal date
 - Replacement must occur within 9 months of removal and must be 1" in diameter 4' above ground
