
**FISCAL IMPACT:**

**RESOLUTION NO. 20-12**

**RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF BANDON, OREGON, DECLARING THE  
CITY'S ELECTION TO RECEIVE STATE REVENUE SHARING  
FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021**

WHEREAS, after due public notice, a public hearing was held before the Budget Committee on May 4, 2020, and a public hearing was held before the City Council on June 1, 2020, giving citizens an opportunity to provide written and oral comments, and ask questions of the hearing body on the proposed use of State Revenue Sharing distributions for fiscal year 2020-2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council that, pursuant to ORS 221.770, the City of Bandon elects to receive State Revenue Sharing funds for fiscal year 2020-2021.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall become effective on July 1, 2020.
