The Bandon Transportation System Plan (TSP) is a plan to guide the City's future transportation system.

What will the TSP do?

The TSP will recommend policies, programs, and physical improvements to streets and sidewalks to address current and future transportation needs in Bandon. The TSP focuses on improving connections and safety conditions for all travelers in Bandon including those who drive, walk, bicycle, use an assistive mobility device, or deliver freight.

What is happening now?

The project team has drafted solutions to address communityidentified issues in town. Solutions include:

- Options for reconfiguring and improving U.S. 101 to address speeding and safety issues
- Safer and more comfortable connections for people walking and biking
- Parking and demand management for busy areas
- Public transportation improvements
- Additional roadway connections

Draft solutions will be further refined through conversations with the community. The final TSP will provide a framework for funding and building these solutions.
