

The Bandon Transportation System Plan (TSP) is a plan to guide the City's future transportation system.

What will the TSP do?

The TSP will recommend policies, programs, and physical improvements to streets and sidewalks to address current and future transportation needs in Bandon. The TSP is focused on improving connections and safety conditions for all travelers in the city including those who drive, walk, bicycle, use an assistive mobility device, or deliver freight.

This plan will evaluate safety, traffic, parking, freight, disaster response, crossing improvements, and future connections to undeveloped areas of Bandon. The TSP will also focus on street improvements along U.S. 101, increasing roadway safety and enhancing access for residents and visitors.

Potential solutions will be based on what we learn from technical analysis and from conversations with the community.

Finally, the TSP will provide a framework for funding and building projects based on community priorities. The plan will include a prioritized list of improvements that reflect community needs that the City can pursue over time.
