What Will Be Accepted?

- Pesticides like DDT, acetamiprid (Assail), carbaryl (Sevin), imidacoprid (Admire, Gaucho, Provado, Marathon) and other leftover pesticides (must pre-register)
- Empty, triple-rinsed or pressure washed plastic pesticide containers (no registration needed) Size limit: 55 gallon HDPE
